### Lamps & Floors

#### Lamps:

Simple bulb socket	A simple socket for light bulbs. Obviously needs electricity to work. Very unembellished, but cheap. Light bulbs cost around 3 \$ a piece.	s.a. 10 \$ up to 20 \$
Lamp shade	A simple socket with a just as simple lamp shade. At least it's a bit more nice looking than just a socket.	s.a. 25 \$ up to 60 \$
Elaborate lamp shade	A much more elaborate lamp shade, often made of glass – or just made with more details and love.	s.a. 50 \$ up to 150 \$
Candleholder (simple)	This is probably a repurposed Christmas tree light from before the War. Prices for candles can be found in the equipment list.	s.a. 15 \$ up to 25 \$
Chandelier (Light bulbs)	An impressive piece. Some of them are even made of gold. Illuminates even the largest room, thanks to up to 25 light bulbs. Light bulbs cost around 3 \$ a piece (not included in the price of the chandelier).	s.a. 270 \$ up to 1000 \$
Chandelier (Candles)	A really impressive piece, even though it's a hell of an effort to light every single candle. Prices for candles are found in the equipment list.	s.a. 300 \$ up to 800 \$

#### Floor covers:

(Prices depending on quality)

Carpet	A large carpet, covering the whole floor. Prices are for one square meter.	s.a. 30 \$ up to 150 \$
Tiles	Relatively large tiles, all across the whole floor. Prices are for one square meter.	s.a. 50 \$ up to 200 \$
Parquet floor	A wooden floor. Very pleasant and beautiful, but damn expensive. Prices are for one square meter.	s.a. 75 \$ up to 300 \$
