

Equipment list – medical equipment:

(please check the chem list for other medicines and similar chemicals)

Antibiotics	A pill capsule penicillin or a similar antibiotic.	s.a. 50 \$ 0,3 pounds
headache pill	A pill against the headache before. Often dissolvable in water. A light pain killer, that even lessens coughs and sneezes as well as joint pains. Nearly a miracle pill.	s.a. 30 \$ 0,2 pounds/ Package
Morphine	A strong painkiller. Lessens petty much every pain, when dosed high enough. Can be addicting and definitely makes you groggy and confused. Do NOT take before combat, if it can be avoided. Before taking it, let yourself be counseled by your doctor, pharmacist or local shaman.	s.a. 50 \$ 0,2 pounds/ package/sy ringe
Antivenom	A drinkable antivenom against radscorpion poison or poisons that are based on that toxin – allegedly even useable against many other poisons, but do you really want to test that hypothesis the hard way? Heals 2 doses of poison.	35 \$ 1 pound
Broadband-Antitoxin	A very potent pre War Antitoxin for front line use. Even helps against chemical warfare agents. Heals 4 doses of poison.	80 \$ 0,5 pounds
Car first-aid box:	Small first aid box, as it could be found in any car before the Great War. Good for three applications. +5 to all rolls in which you treat wounds	30 \$ 3 pounds
Paramedic's bag:	Portable paramedic's equipment, like it came 'freshly' out of an ambulance. Good for seven applications. +10 to all rolls in which you treat wounds	100 \$ 8 pounds
Emergency physician bag/ Field doctor kit:	Good for twelve applications. +20 to all rolls in which you treat wounds	450 \$ 20 pounds
