

Arrows:

Wooden Arrow	
Costs for a 100:	30 \$
Armor adjustment:	No adjustment
Description:	A simple, wooden, arrow. Usually adorned with feathers and sharpened at the front.

Iron Arrow	
Costs for a 100:	60 \$
Armor adjustment:	- 2 to the target's armor.
Description:	An arrow made of cheap iron. Effective, but not as hard as a steel arrow.

Steel arrow	
Costs for a 100:	100 \$
Armor adjustment:	- 4 to the target's armor
Description:	Harder than iron, these arrows can punch through a lot of armor.

Steel arrow with poison cannula	
Costs for a 100:	500 \$
Armor adjustment:	- 3 to the target's armor
Special rule:	Applies one dose of poison, if one is stored in the small bladder.
Description:	This arrow, that contains a little poison filled bladder behind the tip, isn't really suited to hunt animals, but it is quite effective against humans.
